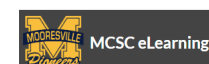

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are excited to announce that Mooresville Consolidated School Corporation will incorporate eLearning Days for the 2019-2020 school year. An eLearning Day will allow students to work remotely in the case of inclement weather. Traditionally, MCSC has had to make up the days at the end of the school year. An eLearning Day will ensure that curriculum pacing guides stay intact and the educational flow is not disrupted. Teachers and students in Kindergarten through 6th grade will use Google Classroom for their eLearning Day. Teachers and students in 7th grade through 12th grade will use Canvas for their eLearning Day. Both Google Classroom and Canvas can be accessed on any device that can connect to the internet. The consistency will better prepare our students for ILEARN, IREAD and AP exams.

When inclement weather causes school to be cancelled, MCSC will have an eLearning Day. Students will be assigned classwork that will be posted by 9:00 a.m on the day of eLearning. Students will have seven days following the eLearning Day to complete all work (to account for internet connectivity issues and special education accommodations). MCSC will provide computer lab hours in the week following an eLearning Day for students who need internet access.

During an eLearning Day, students and parents can communicate online with teachers during their office hours (9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.). Also during eLearning Days, technology staff will be answering technology-related questions through a hotline: 317-834-2424. All students have participated in an eLearning Practice Day. Please check with your child and ask him/her about the experience. If you have any questions prior to an eLearning Day, please reach out to your child's teacher. We realize and understand that our first eLearning Day will be a learning experience for everyone.
