You can also opt out of these messages at any time by simply replying to one of our messages with "Stop".

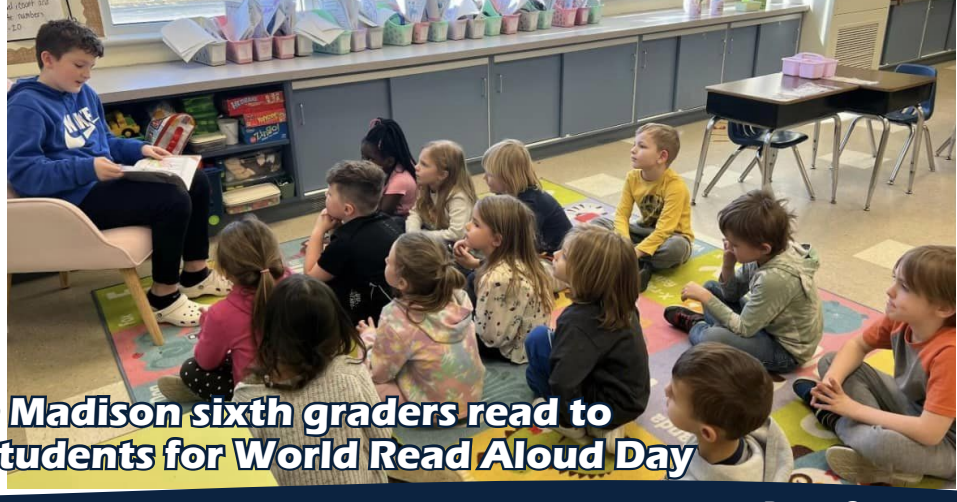

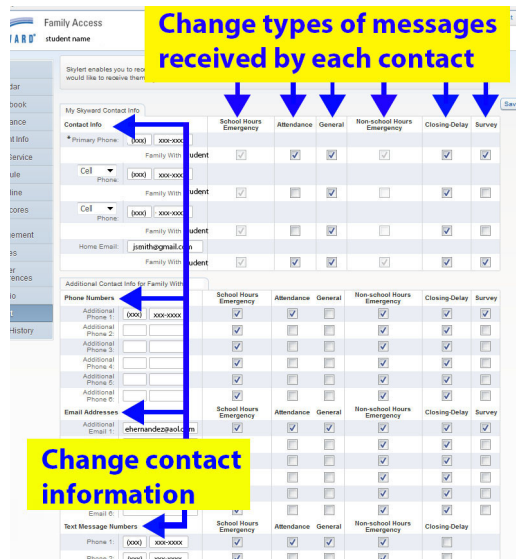
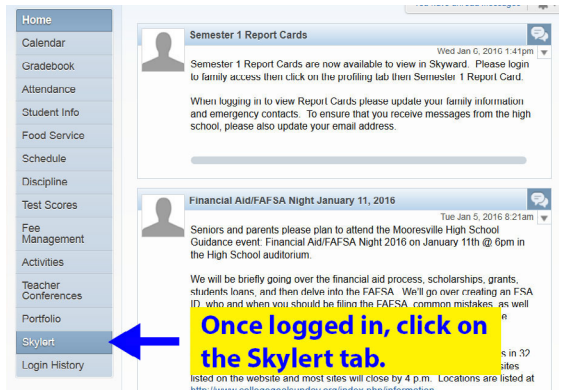
Maximize Your School Communications

With technology today, parents can find their child's attendance, grades, lunch account information and more with the touch of a button. It's even possible to update how school notifications are sent depending on the type of message (weather, general, emergency, etc.).

Families can access this information and personalize their experience through their child's Skyward Family Access account.

By clicking on the "Skylert" tab, parents can choose which types of messages (lunch balance, absent/tardy messages, delays and closures, etc.) are received by which person in the household. This way, families can add caregivers, grandparents, or even teen students to the school closure/delay calls without changing the status of who receives other types of messages.

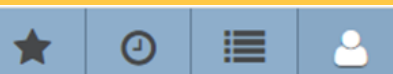

While many Skyward system functions are available in the app, others are more easily found through a desktop view. To access desktop view from the app, (1) click on the three white lines at the top right of your screen. A new menu bar will open (2) and allow you to choose the "account" option (head icon). After that, click the last menu item (3) "Go to Desktop View." Desktop View allows families to see required school forms as well as other important information.
