The Mooreville School Board has announced that Emily Lepore will be the next principal of Waverly Elementary School. Waverly Principal Warren DuBois will retire at the end of this school year.

"Emily is a tremendous asset to our school district and the perfect person to step into the role of Waverly principal," said Superintendent Dr. Jake Allen. "Her experience in leadership, skills working with students of all needs, and strong work ethic made her stand out among the many candidates."

Lepore joined Mooreville Schools in 2019 as a Transition Coordinator and then Dean of Students at MHS. She was promoted to Assistant Director of Special Education, including being the coordinator of the developmental preschool program at Waverly, since 2021. Prior to that, she has worked as an elementary teacher and assistant autism consultant with Pike Township schools and as a middle school teacher with Decatur Township schools as well as working at Cornerstone Autism Center.

"I am very thankful to join the amazing team at Waverly and for the opportunity to serve the community in this new role," said Lepore.

Lepore earned her Bachelors Degree in Elementary Education and her Masters Degree in Educational Leadership from Indiana University. She and her husband Kyle have two children who are Mooreville students.

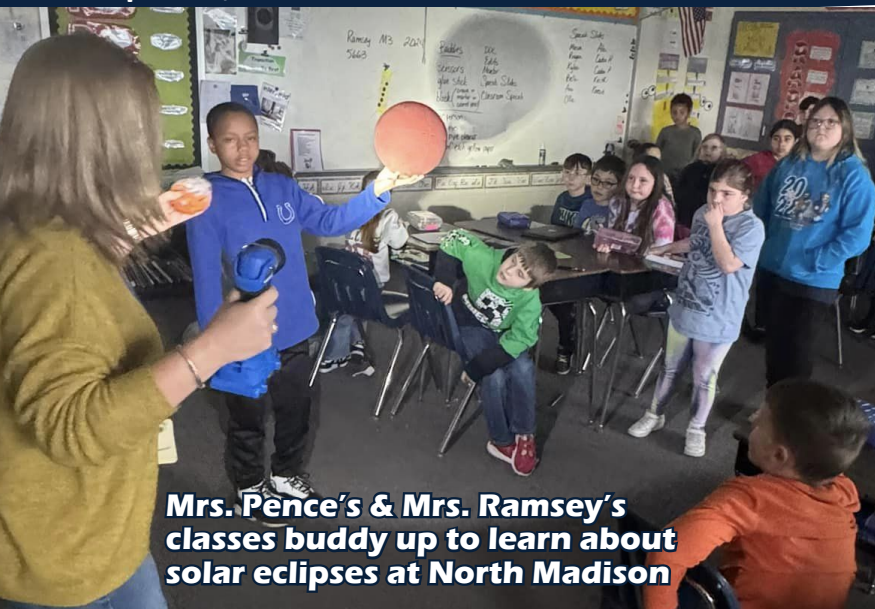

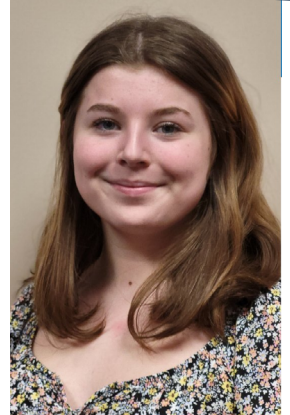
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PHMS' Kennedy Wilson Honored

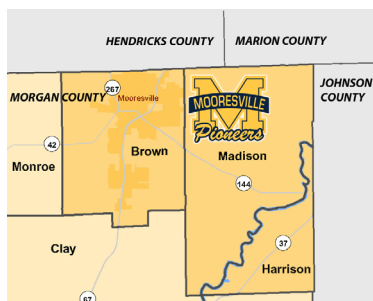
Incoming 7th & 8th graders at 6:00 pm Incoming 9th & 10th graders at 6:45 pm
