

Focus on Safety

Brian Chambers has been sworn in as the new Chief of Police for Mooresville Schools. The addition of Chambers to the school police department puts five officer on duty around the district throughout the school year.

Mooresville Schools has also received \$100,000 in grant funding for safety equipment and technology from the Indiana Department of Homeland Security. Funds will upgrade the security camera system across the district, police department radios, and more.

All schools will take part in their first lockdown drills of the year in

the next two weeks. The state-mandated drills are held in conjunction will local emergency responders. After each drill, officers and school administrators debrief on best practices in case of school emergencies. Drills will be held at Waverly and North Madison on the afternoon of Sept. 28, at Neil Armstrong and Newby on the afternoon of Oct. 10, and at MHS, PHMS and Northwood late next week.

Newby second graders celebrated "Thank a Police Officer Day" by inviting Mooresville Schools, Mooresville, and Morgan County officers to school on Friday. The students made and snack bags for each department.
